# **VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS**

Information Booth	Volunteer at the Tulip Festival Information Booth helping to distribute festival brochures, maps and other City of Albany information. Checks in volunteers.
Road Marshals	Volunteer provides traffic and parking control for artists, vendors, entertainers, and volunteers.
Parking Attendant	Volunteer staffs the offsite VIP and Handicap parking lots ensuring only those with correct permits enter.  *Groups encouraged
Flyer Distribution	Volunteer distributes Tulip Festival flyers and other informational pamphlets throughout Washington Park. *Groups encouraged. This does involve lots of walking.
Vendor Check In	Volunteer directs and assists all vendors during load in period Friday, Saturday and Sunday
